

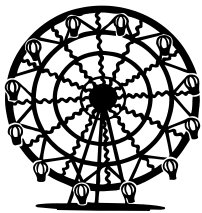

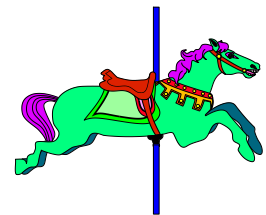

## The Big Glen Burnie Carnival July 26 thru August 3rd (Closed on Sunday)



The end of the school year is almost upon us and soon there will be rides, games of chance, plenty of food, bingo, and lots of excitement at this years Glen Burnie Carnival.

**The Carnival hours have changed and will be Monday through Thursday from 6:30 pm until 10:30 pm. Friday and Saturday from 6:30 pm until 11:00 pm.**

This year the GBIA has chosen a red, 4 door, 2013 Toyota Corolla. The car has keyless remote, cruise control, and gets an average of 29 miles per gallon. Raffle tickets are \$3.00 each or 2 (two) for \$5.00 and can be purchased at the carnival or by contacting the GBIA at 410-760-6760. **You do not need to be present to win.**

Individual ride tickets can be purchased at a cost of \$1.25 per ticket. Most Kiddie rides will require one (1) ticket, Mid-Size rides will require 2 (two) tickets, and the major rides will require three (3) tickets. A book of 30 tickets for \$33.00 and a book of 50 tickets for \$50.00 will be available for purchase. Tickets can be used any night of the carnival. "Ride All Night" Wristbands can be purchased Monday thru Thursday for \$20.00. **No refunds will be given once tickets or wristbands are purchased.**

This year there will be a Sports Wheel that will contain Oriole items as well as Sport Plaques, a Balloon Bust game, and the Goblet game is returning along with the other many popular stands and Bingo. There will be plenty to eat and drink, like hot dogs, pit ham, turkey, beef, French fries, pizza, funnel cakes, ice cream, cotton candy, and candied apples.

So bring your family, friends, relatives, and neighbors out for a great time and great food at the Glen Burnie Carnival.

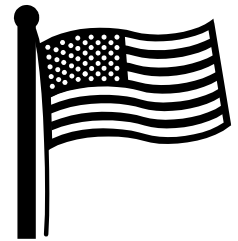
