30th Annual Glen Burnie Memorial Day Parade

The Glen Burnie Memorial Day Parade Committee and the Citizens of Glen Burnie would be honored to have your organization participate in our 30th Annual Memorial Day Parade on **Sunday - May 21, 2017** beginning at 2:00 p.m. We enjoy the benefits of freedom every day and this parade is our small way of paying tribute to those who have made the Ultimate Sacrifice so that we may enjoy the rewards.

DATE: May 21, 2017

LOCATION and ROUTE: All units will assemble at Corkran Middle School on Quarterfield Road. Route will be Quarterfield Road to Crain Highway, north (left) on Crain Highway to Post 40 Road. East (right) on Post 40 Road. Vehicles should proceed to the Courthouse Parking Area and Marchers to the Carnival Grounds for disbursement to keep remaining participants moving.

WHO: Everyone is welcome! A variety of awards will be offered and mailed to winners.

There is no entrance fee for the parade but registration is required. Prior to parade day, you will be notified of lineup position and scheduled arrival time. The cut-off date for registration is May 1, 2017. Those who do not register will be placed at the end of the lineup and will not be eligible for awards.

For safety purposes, units are not allowed to throw candy or promotional materials to the crowd. Participants may hand materials to the crowd on the side of the road but no items are to be thrown to the spectators.

To ensure continued movement of the parade, participants may not stop to perform or cause unnecessary delays between groups. **All entrants who perform along the parade route must use a routine that allows them to perform "in motion" – continuously moving forward along the parade route.**

Additionally, participants are not permitted to enter or exit a moving vehicle at any time. All participating motorized units are required to have proper tags and adequate insurance coverage.


All animals must be leashed or harnessed. Entries that include live animals must assign someone within the unit to immediately clean up after the animals throughout the parade route.

Participants will be allowed to perform in front of the Reviewing Stand. Performances are limited to **two (2) minutes**. Exceeding the allowed performance time will result in disqualification from awards. The Reviewing Stand will be located in front of the GBIA Building at 19 Crain Highway, South.
